# FCC COVID-19 RESPONSE



## **Operating Status**

The FCC remains **open** and **active**. All deadlines for filings, reports, comments and reply comments, etc., **remain the same unless otherwise indicated by the FCC**. The FCC has issued revised instructions for hand-delivered documents on their website.

#### E-Rate

- Waived gift rules through Sept. 30, 2020
- **Extended** deadline for funding year 2020 Form 471 submission to Apr. 29, 2020
- **Granted** all applicants with a 14-day extension for PIA requests
- **Granted** 30-day extension for responding to information requests related to pending appeals, invoices, FCC Form 500 requests, and audits
- **Extended** the service delivery deadline for non-recurring services and special construction to Sept. 30, 2021 and June 30, 2021, respectively
  - Special construction extension applies to funding year 2018 applicants that already received a one-year extension
- Granted 60-day extension to submit requests for review or waiver



#### E-Rate Continued...

- Granted 120-day extension of the invoice filing deadline for any funding request with an invoice deadline between Mar. 11, 2020 and Oct. 28, 2020
- Granted 30-day extension for applicants to file invoice extension requests
- **Granted** 120-day extension of FCC Form 486 deadlines falling between Mar. 11, 2020 and Sept. 30, 2020



#### **Rural Health Care**

- **Waived** gift rules through Sept. 30, 2020
- Extended deadline for Form 462 and Form 466 applications to June 30, 2020
- Permitted FY 2019 evergreen contract holders to extend those through FY 2020 and waived voluntary extension requirements
- Extended the service delivery deadline for one year
- Extended the invoice filing deadline by 180 days
- **Extended** the 60-day request for appeal/waiver deadline to provide 120 days to file for all deadlines from Mar. 11 through Sept. 30, 2020
- Extended the 14-day deadline for information request responses to provide 42 days for all responses to requests issued on or before Sept. 30, 2020

#### **High-Cost**

- Waived consumer fees for hundreds of rural phone and broadband providers
- Waived requirements that mobile competitive ETCs spend legacy highcost support money in particular service areas until June 30, 2020



#### Lifeline

- Waived recertification, reverification, and non-usage "involuntary deenrollment" rules until May 29, 2020
- **Extended** deadline for enrollment representative registration with USAC until May 29, 2020



## Keep Americans Connected 60-Day Pledge

- Signatories have agreed to:
  - 1. not terminate service to any residential or small business customers;
  - 2. waive any late fees incurred by residential or small business customers;
  - 3. open its Wi-Fi hotspots to any American who needs them.
- **680** service providers and **17** trade associations have taken the pledge

### **Additional Steps Taken By Providers**

 Dozens of major service providers have gone further, waiving fees and offering service plans aimed at helping low-income households and individuals maintain or receive Internet access



#### **Connected Care Pilot**

 Adopted three-year, \$100M program for pilot projects that use telehealth to deliver "medical, diagnostic, and treatment-related services."

### **COVID-19 Telehealth Program**

- Adopted alongside the Connected Care Pilot
- Creates \$200M (from the CARES Act) fund to allow eligible health care providers to purchase "telecommunications services, information services, and devices necessary to provide critical connected care services."
  - Streamlined, rolling application process



#### **Other Actions**

- Granted major wireless carriers, wireless internet service providers, and a tribal provider Special Temporary Authority (STA) to access additional spectrum resources
- Granted Inteliquent, Inc. a waiver of the Access Stimulation definition until June 1, 2020, due to increased Zoom and Cisco WebEx terminating traffic
- Clarified that hospital, healthcare provider, and government COVID-19 communications fall within "emergency purposes" exception to the TCPA
- Waived several TRS and VRS rules
- **Extended** filing, comment, and/or transition deadlines in the 5.9 GHz, net neutrality, 3.5 GHz, and television auction dockets

- Financial services providers TCPA Petition for Expedited Declaratory Ruling (03/30/2020)
- CTIA ex parte on spectrum access and STAs (04/03/2020)

# II. Congressional COVID-19 Response

## **CARES Act - Signed 03/27/2020**

- \$200M for FCC
  - The FCC adopted the previously discussed COVID-19 Telehealth Program
- \$125M for USDA
  - \$100M for ReConnect Program
  - \$25M for distance learning and telemedicine initiatives in USDA's Rural Development program



# II. Congressional COVID-19 Response

#### H.R. 6379 - Take Responsibility for Workers and Families Act

- Bill currently includes the following appropriations for the FCC:
  - \$200M for telehealth services
  - \$2B for "Emergency Connectivity Fund", to provide Wi-fi hotspots and connected devices to schools and libraries
  - **\$1B** for "Emergency Broadband Connectivity Fund", for "the provision of an emergency Lifeline broadband benefit."
- H.R. \_\_\_ -- Serving Rural America Act
  - **\$500M** for a five-year pilot grant program at the FCC authorizing \$100M million a year to expand broadband service to unserved areas of the country.




